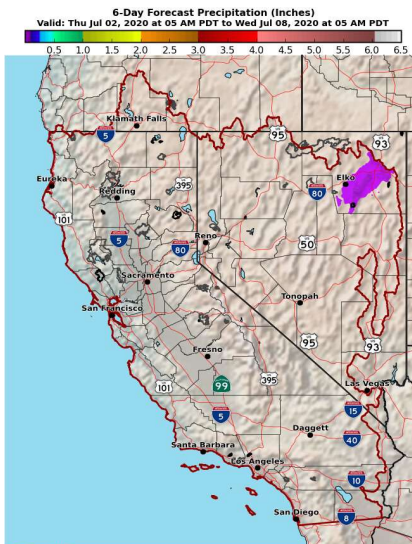
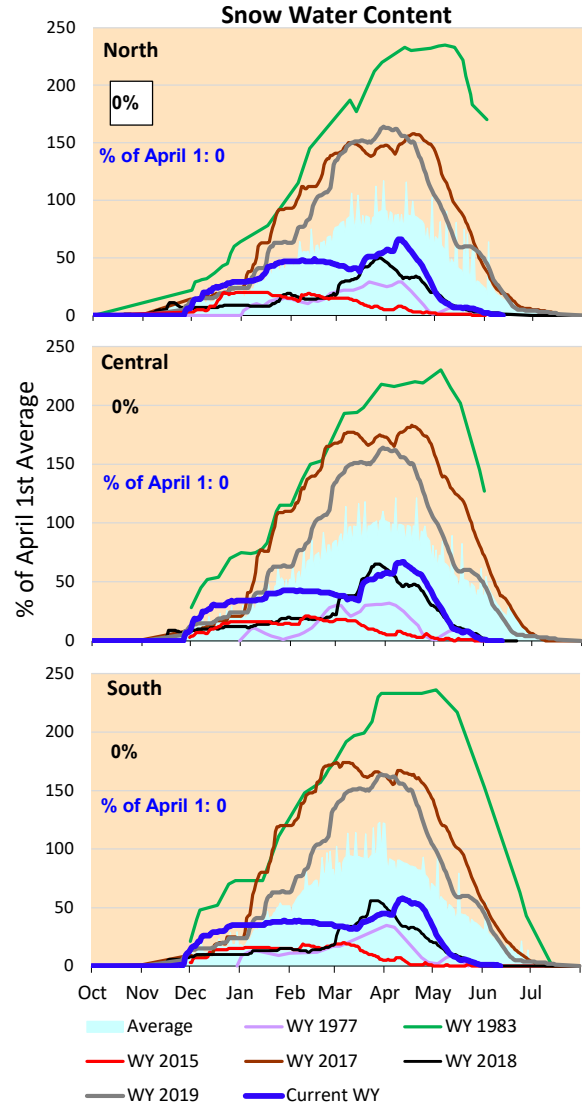
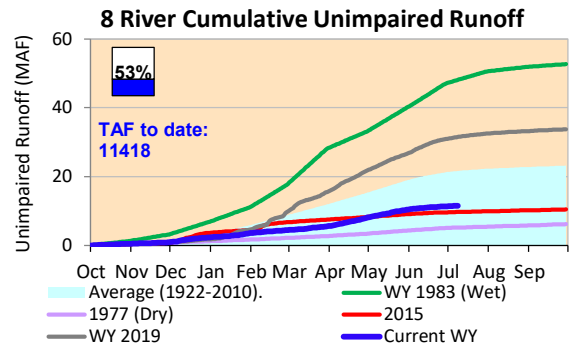

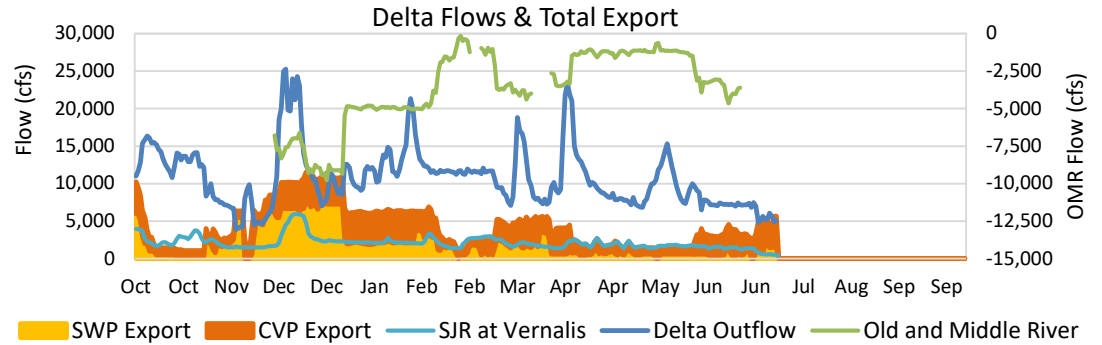


Project Operations

Oroville storage running below average for this time of year, reflecting fairly dry winter. Delta exports increasing now with X2 and OMR standards dropping off in July. Exports for the remainder of the summer controlled by upstream reservoir supply availability, with outflow as required to meet West Delta Agricultural standards.
