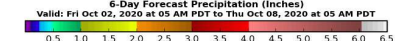
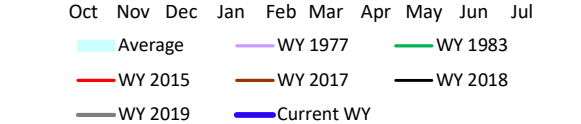
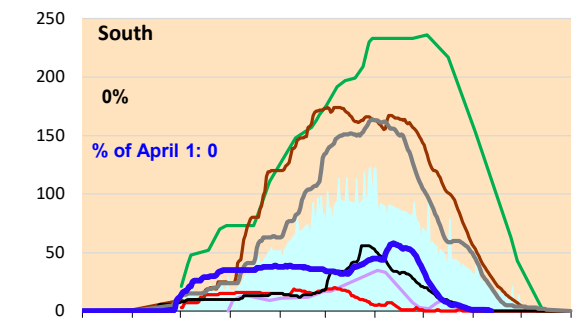
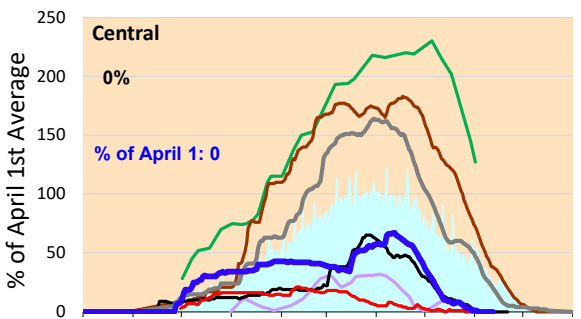
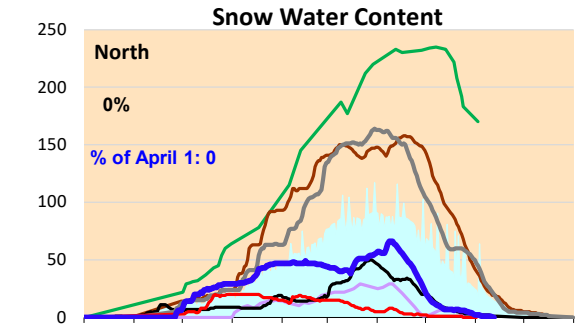


Projected precipitation continues to be insignificant; normal for this time of the year. Snowmelt has essentially completed, with remaining snowpack at zero percent in the Sierras.

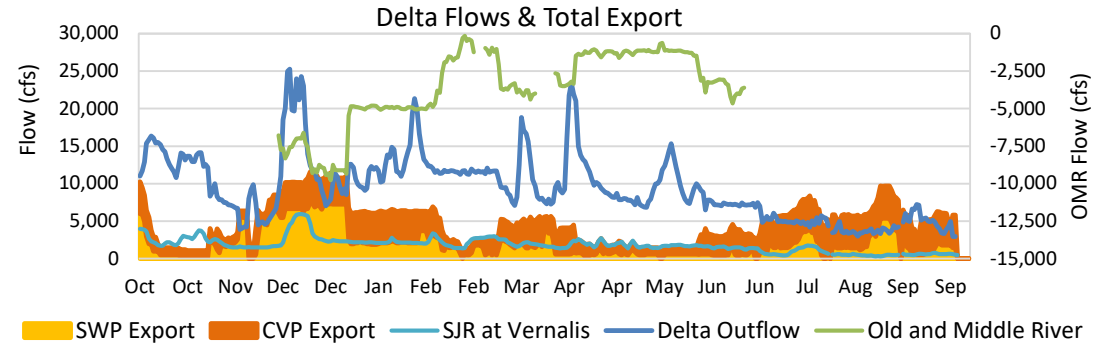




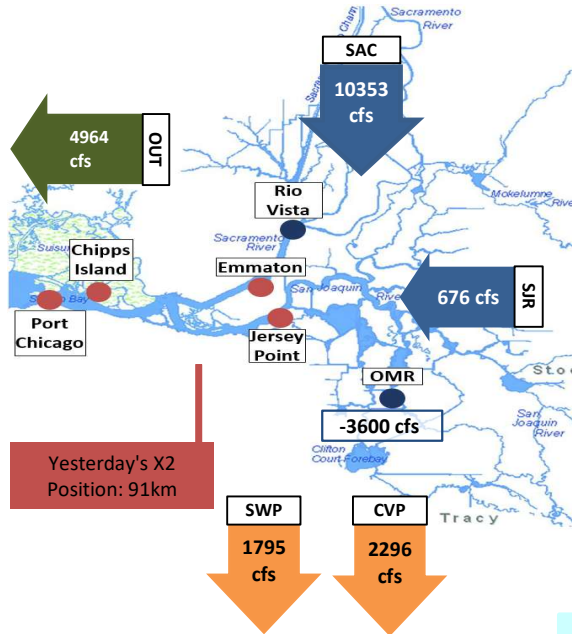
Project Operations

Oroville storage running below average for this time of year, Due to dry winter. Delta exports increased starting July 1, with X2 and OMR standards dropping off. Exports for the remainder of the summer controlled by upstream reservoir supply availability, with outflow as required to meet salinity standards. SWP exports have been low due to limited Oroville storage availability. Continuing low-level CVP use of Joint Point for CVP Project water over the last week.
