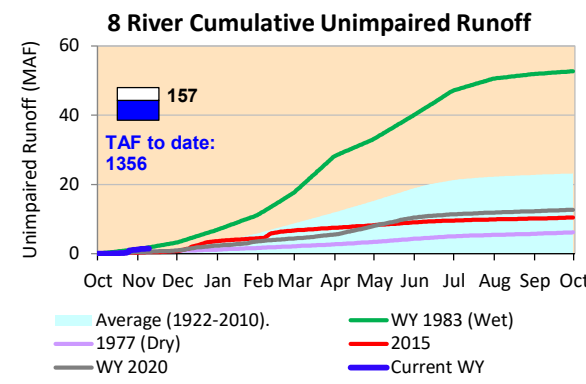
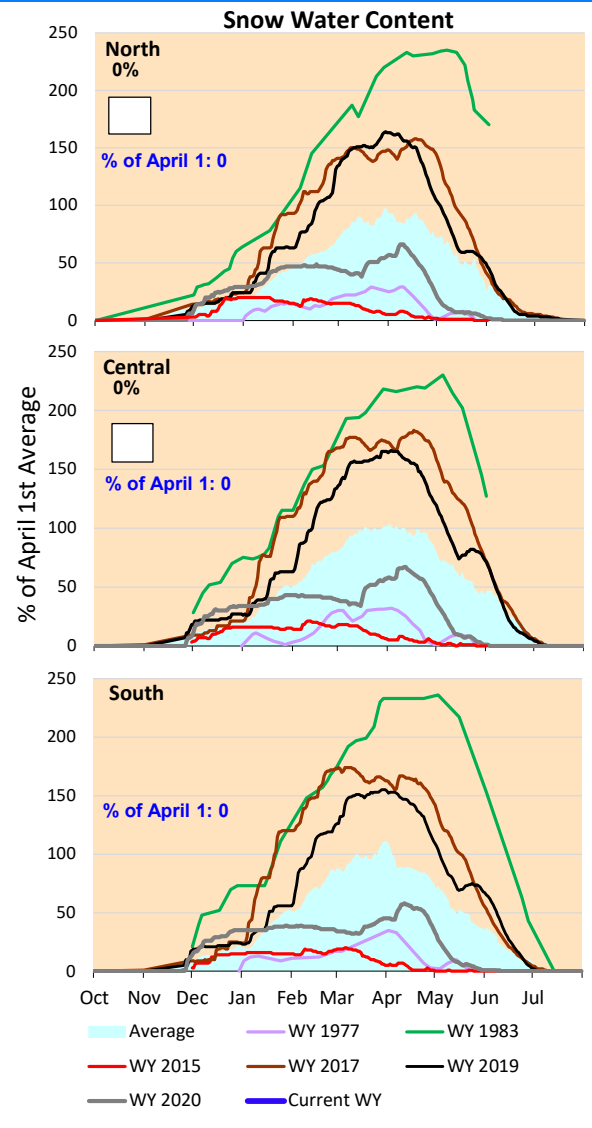
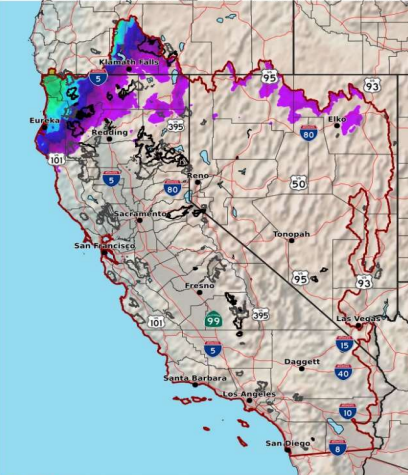
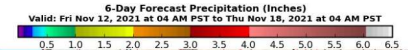


Intense rainfall has ceased, with only light precipitation expected in the far north coast and inland to Shasta Lake. Dry conditions prevail with no significant snowpack yet. Cumulative precipitation so far this water year is well above normal for this time of year. Forecasts call for dry conditions through mid November.

6-Day Forecast Precipitation (inches)





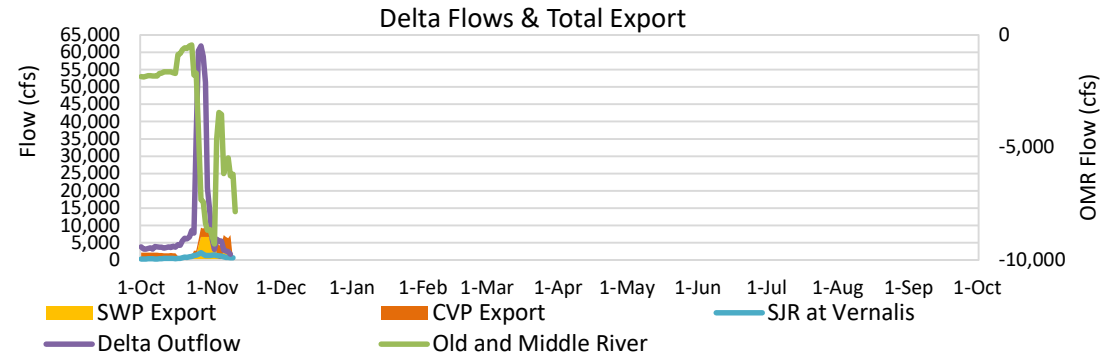

Delta outflow conditions continue to be balanced with salinity management controlling operations. Delta inflows decreased from last week and SWP exports have increased temporarily. Even with the increased storage at Folsom and Oroville, they are still running below average and other historic dry year levels for this time of year.
