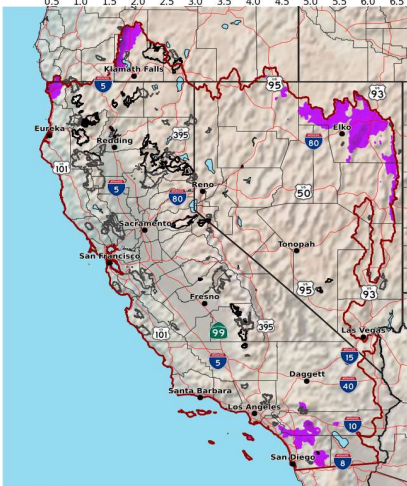

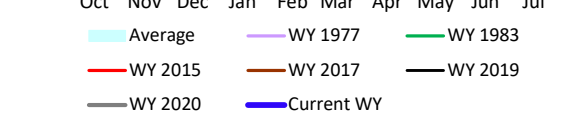

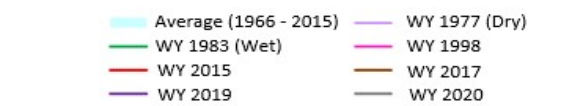

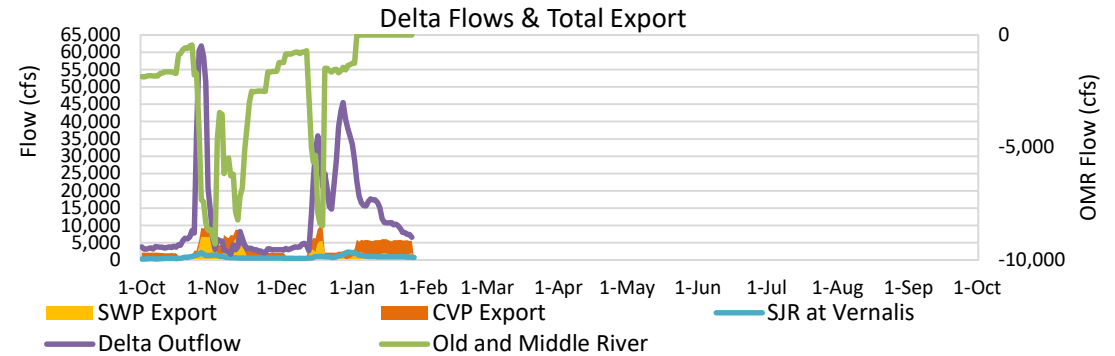

Delta outflow conditions continue to be 'excess with EI concerns' with Old and Middle River flows restricting exports. Delta inflows and outflow decreased from last week, but SWP and CVP exports have been relatively stable, limited by Old and Middle River restrictions. Shasta and Oroville storage continues to increase but still running below average level for this time of year. The storage at Folsom is analogous to the historic average level and now at Flood reservation space with higher releases. Note: Yesterday's X-2 Position is estimated.
