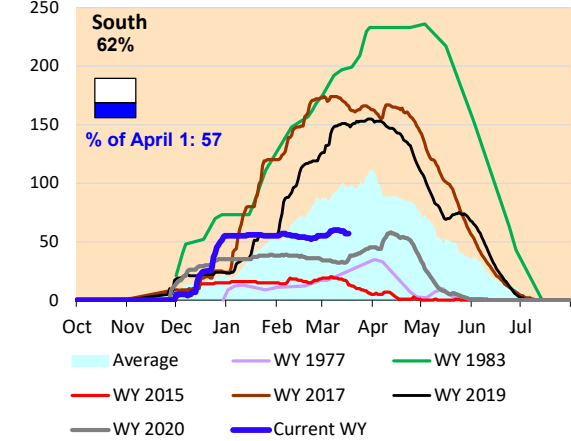
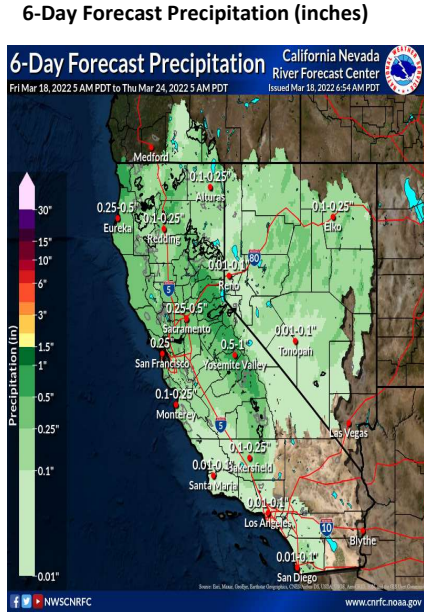
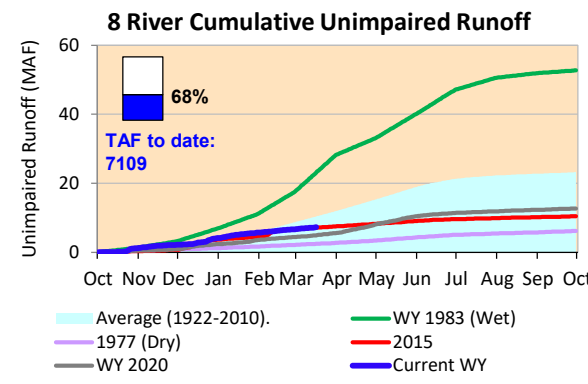
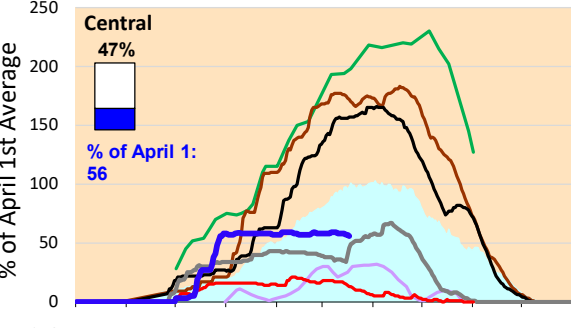
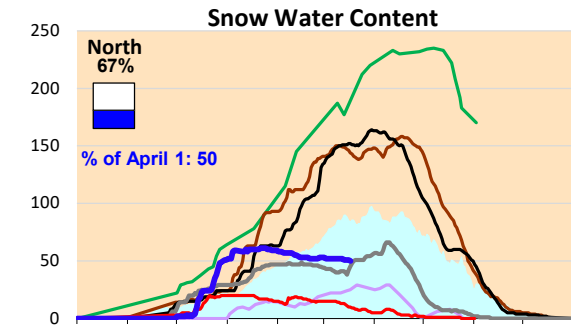


Minimal precipitation is forecast for the California for this weekend. The cumulative precipitation and snow water content remain steady and are lower than the average values for this time of year. Actual runoff is marginally lower than the historical average rates.

*Note: Percentages in each plot refers to percent of average for this date. When historic data is unavailable, Snow Water Content Bar plot is not shown. The percent of historic average for each SWC location differs slightly from CDEC's report due to small discrepancies in historical data.



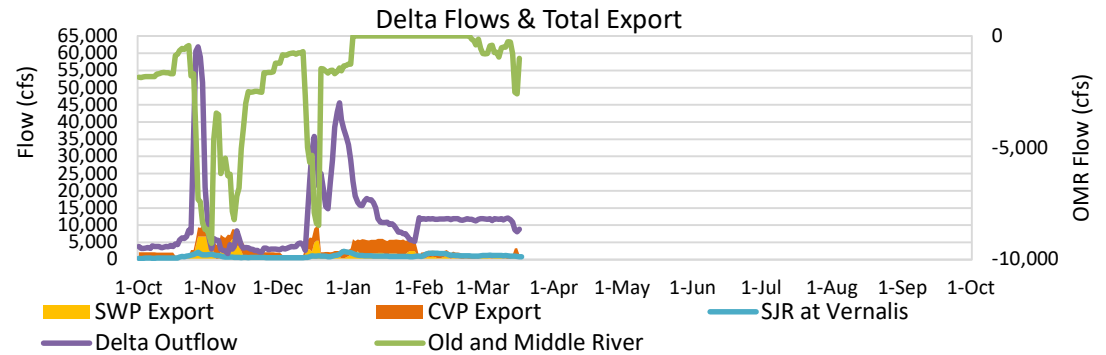


Project Operations

Delta outflow conditions continue to remain 'balanced'. The X2 requirement at Chippis Island in March was completed and the compliance point is at Collinsville for the remainder of the month. With the completion of the Chippis Island X2 requirement Delta inflows and outflows were reduced this week. CVP and SWP exports also increased this week. Shasta and Oroville storage are still running below average level for this time of year and are close to dry conditions experienced in 1977. The storage at Folsom remains relatively constant from last week, which is lower than the historic average level.
