



Little precipitation is forecast for Northern California this weekend. Cumulative precipitation for the Sierras remains below average for this time of year. The snow water content is significantly below the average values for this time of year. Actual runoff is lower than the historical average rates, close to conditions experienced in 2020.

* Note: Percentages in each plot refers to percent of average for this date. When historic data is unavailable, Snow Water Content Bar plot is not shown. The percent of historic average for each SWC location differs slightly from CDEC's report due to small discrepancies in historical data.
