



Small amounts of precipitation are forecasted for the California through the end of January. Cumulative precipitation for the Sierras are above average value for this time of year. The snow water content is above the average values for this time of year. Actual runoff is higher than the historical average rates, close to conditions experienced in 1983.

*Note: Percentages in each plot refers to percent of average for this date. When historic data is unavailable, Snow Water Content Bar plot is not shown. The percent of historic average for each SWC location differs slightly from CDEC's report due to small discrepancies in historical data.
